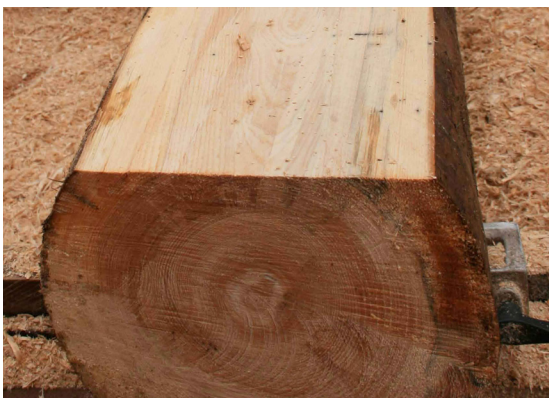
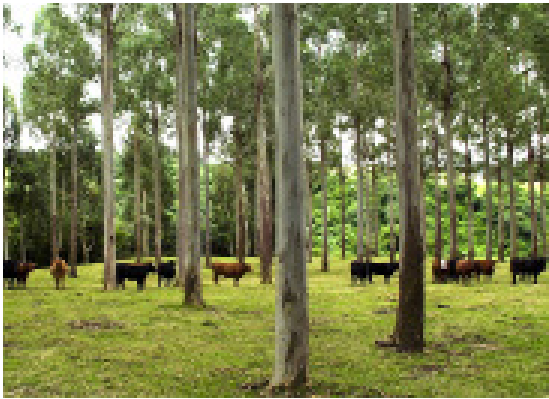




Trees on Farms - Field Day - Primary
