The Forest Education Foundation (FEF) run a range of programs, lead by experienced teachers, which can be run at forest sites, at schools and at the National Forest Learning Centre in Hobart.

National Forest Learning Centre

The National Forest Learning Centre is based in Melville Street, Hobart.

The purpose built Centre runs programs for groups of all ages.

The FEF teachers work with you to plan the program prior to your visit. All sessions are handson with a range of activities, and support the new Australian Curriculum.

Cost: \$100 per group

Forest Discovery Experience

The Forest Discovery Experience brings our teachers and the activities from the National Forest Learning Centre to your local area.

Supply the space, we set up and run the activities.

Suitable for classes of all ages, and covering a range of topics, including forest types and ecology, forest management and products, and peoples interactions with forests.

Cost \$100 per class (max 25). Minimum of 5 sessions required to run the program. Classes from other schools can also visit.

Field Trip Programs

We run day long trips to local forest areas across the state.

We have programs developed for primary, secondary and Yr 11/12 classes.

Schools in the south can explore the Southern Forests and around Hobart, whilst northern schools have the opportunity to explore the Hollybank Reserve or Cluan Tiers.

We provide all the equipment, schools organise their own transport and lunch. Cost: \$150 per group
