If I were a Tree

K-2

This kit explores an important part of a forest – Trees!

Students examine the features of trees and their role in supporting other living things in the forest.

Activities Includes:

- Forest specimens and magnifying glasses
- Parts of a tree
- Forest finger puppets
- Forest songs and stories
- Tree Time tasks



Forest Interconnections

Year 3/4

This kit explores the concept of living and non-living things in a forest.

Identify who is eating who and how all parts of the forest are interconnected.

Activities Includes:

- Forest specimens and magnifying glasses
- Living and Non-living parts of a forest
- Interactive food web
- Tree Time tasks



Adaptation Station

Year 5/6

This kit explores the characteristics of Tasmania's forests.

Identify the adaptations of living-things and look at forest specimens in microscopes.

Activities Include:

- Forest specimens and high powered light microscopes
- Forest types of Tasmania
- Adaptations in the forest
- Creature features
- Tree Time tasks
