OUR PURPOSE

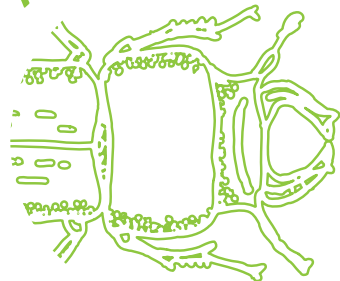
Inspire Tasmanian educators and learners to explore the stories behind our trees.
